

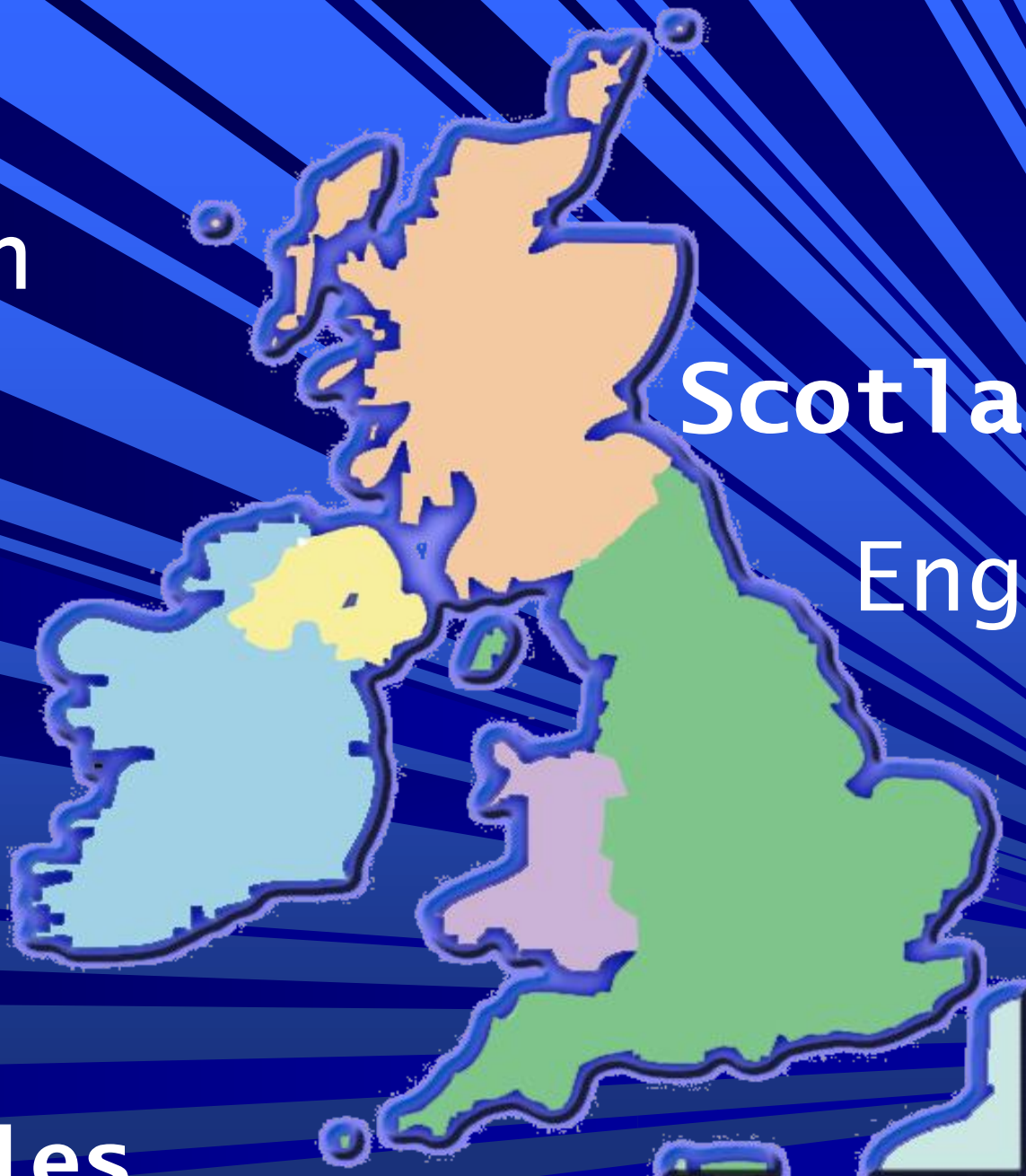

These are toy buses. They are double-decker buses. You can see them in London.





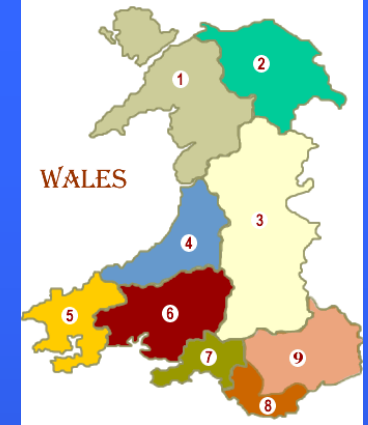
Pin

This is a hat. It has got shamrocks on it. The shamrock is the national symbol of Ireland.

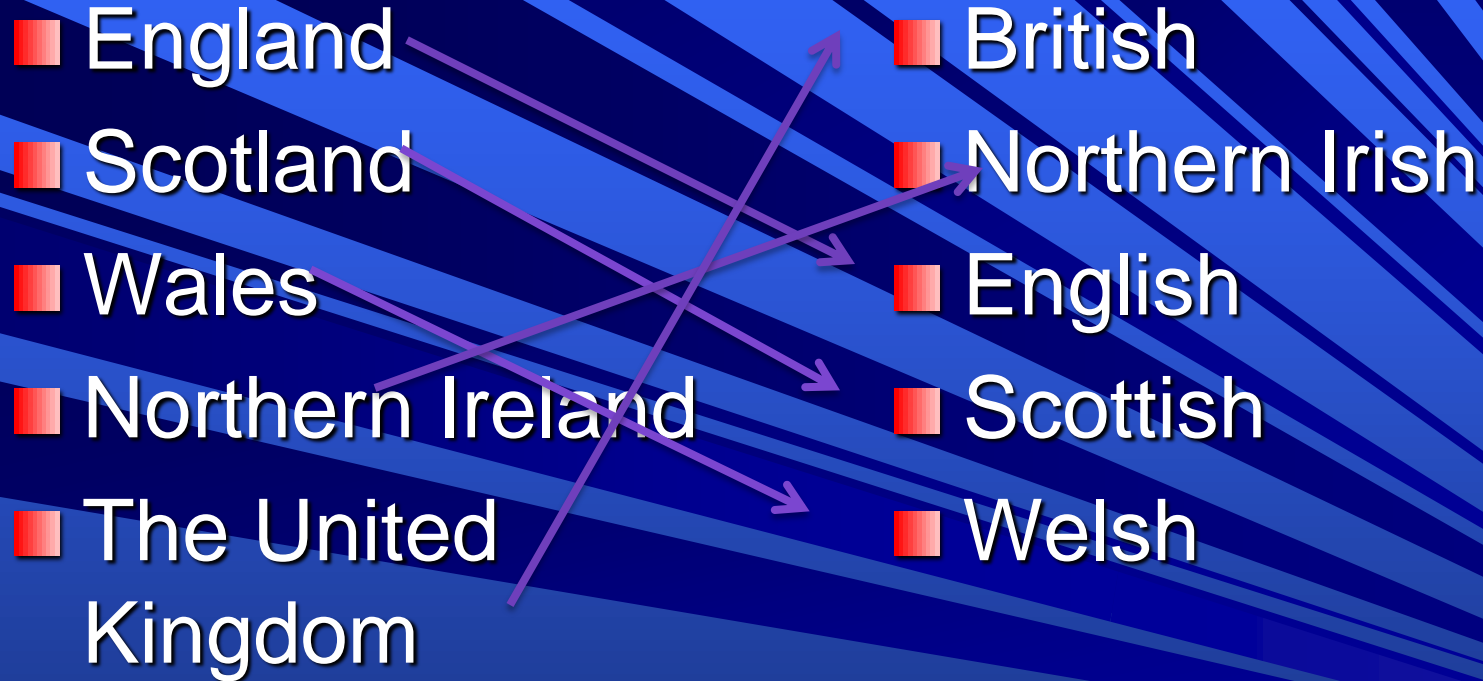


What other souvenirs can we buy in the UK?


